

EU Import Control System 2 (ICS2) Overview

ICS2 Requirements, release dates and affected parties.

What is ICS2?

ICS2 is an EU Information Control system that requires **essential cargo information** to be declared for Customs to **identify early safety and security risks** to intervene and control the movement of goods to the EU territory.

Who is affected directly by ICS2?

For EU and Non-EU



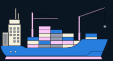

WHAT HAPPENS WITH ICS2?

1. Carriers or stakeholders file **ENS (Entry Summary Declaration)**.
2. **Early Safety and Security Risk analysis** performed by the Customs.
3. Notice of arrival to the Customs.
4. Customs may **inspect or reject goods** if potential alert raised at early analysis.

WHEN IS ICS2 EFFECTIVE?

REASONS FOR CUSTOMS REJECTION

1

Dangerous Goods

The item descriptions indicate potential hazardous items, that are non-compliant to the transport safety regulations (i.e. IATA, IMDG)

2

Missing HS code or inadequate descriptions

The declarants must provide **6-digit HS codes** and adequate descriptions of the goods (one-liner or generic descriptions no longer accepted).

3

Inaccurate or lack of ENS data

If the required information is not provided or inaccurate, goods will be **stopped** at the EU Customs border and will **not be processed for customs clearance**.

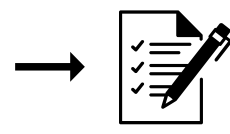


How does Moaah help with ICS2?
